

Who can come to the Poly Drive Elementary PTA end of the year party?

All Poly Drive students, accompanied by a parent, guardian or responsible adult. Students are expected to follow adults' instructions, to maintain a safe environment for themselves and others. This is not a School District 2 or Poly Drive Elementary School event. Parents/guardians are responsible for their own children.

What are the expectations for behavior/conduct at the party?

Students will respect school property and individuals. This means

- not littering (i.e., food wrappers and other garbage)
- appropriate language and behavior (i.e., no swearing, respectful of one another, taking turns)
- following adult volunteers instructions

Students who choose to not follow these expectations will have to leave the party.

What is this waiver for?

The waiver is needed for students to use the equipment that will be at the party. This includes inflatable basketballs, inflatable ponies, interactive dragon, water guns, and a climbing wall.

What should I bring? No student may use the equipment without a signed waiver on record.

You may bring your lunch to picnic with friends during the party. Two food trucks (*Cooking Ol' Broads (Hot Dogs)* and *Montana Melt Grilled Cheese Sandwiches*) and frozen treats (*Summer Snow* and *Bailey's Frozen Novelties*) will also be available for purchase.

How much does it cost?

Use of the equipment and participating in activities is free for students. This event is sponsored by the Poly Drive PTA, which makes the free admission possible. Food truck and frozen treat items are not free, so bring money if you plan to purchase them.

Where can I go during the party?

The party is going to be held on the playground/lawn area located on the southside of the Poly Drive campus (behind the school building). **There is absolutely no access inside the school building once school is dismissed at 11:45 a.m.** Porta-potties will be available outside.

Why are there volunteers if parents are responsible for their children?

Volunteers are needed because this is a PTA-sponsored event (rather than school/school district). In order to make things run smoothly, we need helping hands!
